Introduction

KIP Switch is a simple application that quickly converts image data into either PDF to TIFF G4 files. Supported file formats for conversion is TIFF, HPGL/2, CALS, DWF, DWFx, PDF. This advanced Batch Converter does exactly what its title suggests, allowing you to easily convert multiple print files at the click of a button. Developed from KIP's latest PrintNET technology, KIP Switch's functionality and easy-to-use interface makes file conversion quick, easy, and accurate.

System Requirements

The recommended minimum computer requirements;

- CPU = 1.8 GHz CPU
- Ram = 512 MB
- Harddisk = 40 GB
- Windows XP/7 - 32/64 bit OS

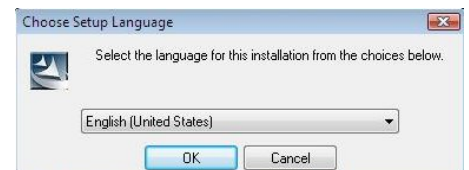


Installation

To install the KIP Switch (also known as KIP Convert Kit) software follow these steps:

Run the KIP Switch install executable

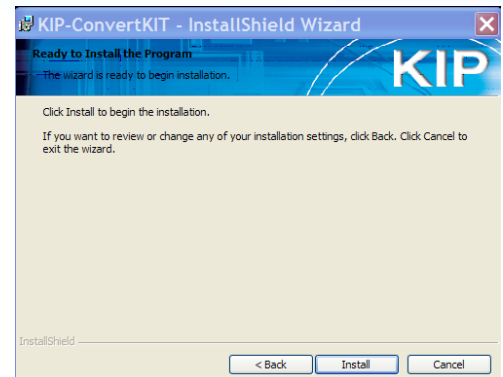
1. Choose the desired language.
2. Select next

3. Select your choice for the "End User license agreement" and select next.

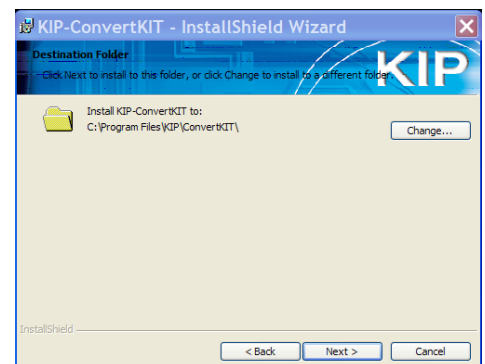


4. Accept the install location (default) or select: Change: to install to a different location.



5. Select Install to begin the install process.

6. Select to Launch the KIP Switch application



7. Select "Finish" to complete the installation



KIP Switch - Use

Convert images using the following procedure:

1. There should now be a small KIP icon in the right corner of the screen (system tray). If this icon is not shown, launch the software manually using the Windows explorer to browse to:

C:\Program Files\KIP\KIPConvert\Kconvert.exe.

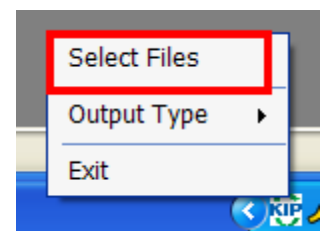
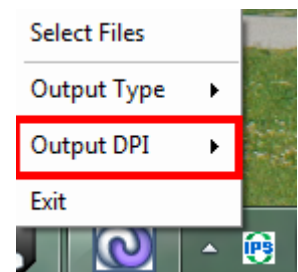
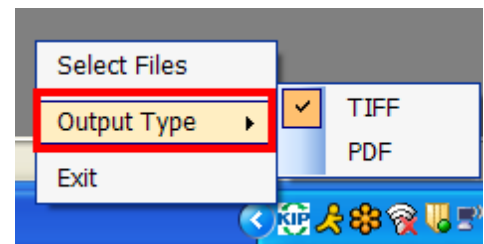
This will launch the KIP icon in the system tray.

2. Right click on the KIP icon.
3. Select "Output Type"

- a. Tiff
- b. PDF



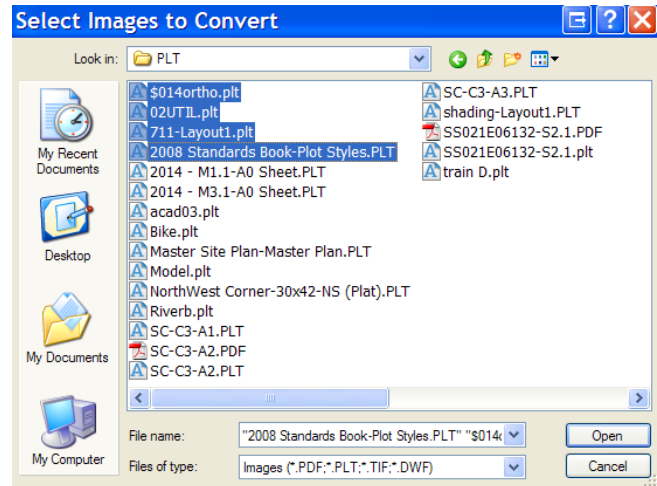
4. Right Click the KIP Icon again
5. Select the desired DPI 200, 300, 400 or 600
6. Right Click on the Icon one more time to "Select Files" that will be converted to the format noted in #3.



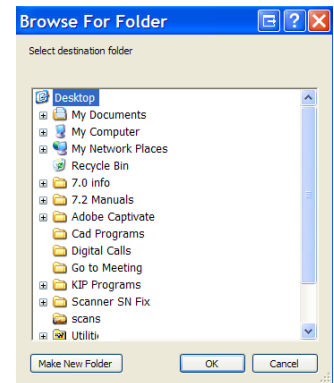

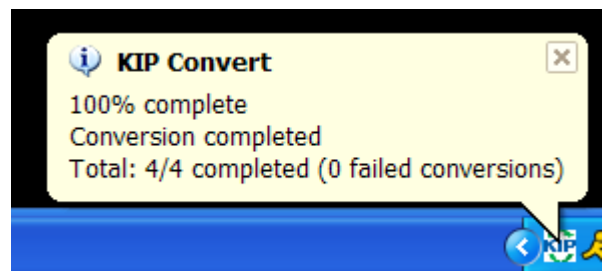
7. Browse and select the files to be converted.



8. Select the location where the converted files are to be saved.



9. When the files have been converted the following message will appear.



10. Use your Windows Explorer to access the converted files.
